CULTURAL COMPETITIONS

Competition: Design a flag to represent young people competing in the School Games for your district or town.

Age Range: Year 5

Brief: Design and create a piece of artwork in the form of a flag which is inspired by sport, in particular the Schools Games and values.

The spirit of the School Games values focus on personal excellence through competition. The 5 values of respect, determination, passion, honesty, team work & self belief were developed by young people to identify what the experience of school sport should be built around.



How to: Using the presentation and lesson plan introduce the participating children to the task. The children can work individually or in pairs to design their artwork on an A3 or A4 plain paper. The flag must be hand drawn or painted by a child (no IT usage). Please remember that the flag will be made up so please consider what the images or designs would look like much bigger.

What next: Once your children have completed their artwork, they must complete the written explanation on the worksheet. Schools must select 1 winner to be forwarded to your local School Games Organiser. The competition pathway is described below.

Intra School Level 1

Competition within school between forms / groups or individuals. To be experienced by as many young people as possible

Inter School Level 2

Competition between local schools to select a local winner to progress to county level.

Inter District Level 3

County School Games Festival
Showcasing the best Lancashire has to offer in Sport & Culture

Judging Criteria:

Entries will be judged on the following criteria;

1. Good Visual Impact
 - Repeating shapes, patterns, and symmetry.
 - Colours which complement or enhance each other.
 - Correct or appealing proportions of figures and objects.
 - Presentation and framing
2. Skill & Technique
3. Inherent meaning / Inspiration
4. Uniqueness
5. Intent & purpose, creative links to sport and the School Games
