



LANCASHIRE SCHOOL GAMES CULTURAL COMPETITIONS

Competition: Write a **spirit of sport pledge** / poem to represent the diversity of young people competing in the School Games for your district or town.

Age Range: Year 6

Brief: Create a piece of written work in the form of a pledge, poem or oath to address the young people who participate in the 2019 SPAR Lancashire School Games at the opening ceremony. Inspired by young people, diversity and importantly the Olympic and Schools Games and their values.

The spirit of the School Games values focusses on personal excellence through competition. The 5 values of respect, determination, passion, honesty, team work & self-belief were developed by young people to identify what the experience of school sport should be built around.



How to: Using the presentation introduce the participating children to the task. The children can work individually or in pairs to write their pledge on the worksheet provided.

What next: Once the children have completed their written piece, they must explain on the reverse of worksheet what inspired them to write it. Schools must select 1 winner to be forwarded to your local School Games Organiser. The competition pathway is described below.

Intra School Level 1

Competition within school between forms / groups or individuals. To be experienced by as many young people as possible

Inter School Level 2

Competition between local schools to select a local winner to progress to county level.

Inter District Level 3

County School Games Festival
Showcasing the best Lancashire has to offer in Sport & Culture

Judging Criteria: Entries will be judged on the following criteria;

1. Spelling, punctuation and grammar
2. Original and imaginative
3. Structure
4. Intent & purpose
5. Creative links to Sport and importantly the School Games

Level 2 Winner Announced: Friday 22nd May 2020

Level 3 Winner Announce: From Monday 8th June 2020
